If you think Vibiana looks an awful lot like a church, you're right. Once the city's first Catholic Archdiocese cathedral, the place still retains its Spanish Baroque-inspired facade, but indoors it's been transformed into a secular space for large-scale, glamorous affairs. Naturally, many brides have chosen the site for their special day, and not least because of its incredible acoustics, gorgeous vaulted ceilings, dramatic marble columns, and black-and-white marble floor. The coolest part? The cathedral's old confessionals can be turned into photo booths, while the altar is now a white marble stage practically begging for a live band.
